The Women's Giving Circle was founded in 2013 by a group of women to support projects relating to women and children's needs in the Morden area. We set up a fund with the Morden Area Foundation. The Circle meets once every fall to grant (donate) the income our fund has earned.

In 2013 we donated \$3,500 to the Healthy Minds Breakfast Program at the Minnewasta School and \$1,500 to the Many Hands Resource Centre in Morden. Both of these groups take active roles in feeding hungry women and children in our community.

At our meeting the Circle voted to focus on charities supporting health and wellness for women and children in 2014. We will meet on November 27th to review grant applications and vote (by ballot) on which projects our money will support. The Circle has been offered matching funds from the Winnipeg Foundation and an anonymous donor. The first \$12,000 in donations received from now until our annual meeting on November 27th will be doubled! We are also receiving \$2,000 from the Winnipeg Foundation for immediate granting and another \$2,000 from the anonymous donor if we hit these fundraising goals.

The Circle is open to any woman who makes a \$200 donation. Each member is allowed one vote. The Circle meets once every fall to make decisions about granting and future areas of interest. We encourage our members to continue giving to the Circle so we can grow our fund and continue to donate together each year. Donations can also be made in honour of or in memory of loved ones.

All of the members of the Giving Circle are listed on our website. We will also be placing an ad in a local paper acknowledging the new members who have joined the Circle as well as the charter members who have made further donations since our inaugural meeting.

Please help us reach our goal of 200 members this year, and help us access this wonderful gift of \$12,000 in matching funds. When we work together, we can impact our community today, tomorrow, and forever.
