



In 1946, the Kinsmen Club of Morden established the Meritorious Service Award at the suggestion of its first honorary member, Judge J.M. George. The first recipient of the “Citizen of the Year” award was George E. Cox.

The final Kinsmen Award was presented in 2002, the year the Morden Kinsmen Club ceased operation. From 1946 to 2002, 57 citizens were recognized for their outstanding community service.
